Gary mentioned that Dennis Eksktrom is now in charge of the Ekstrom properties. He lives in Prescott, Arizona. He may be at the March General meeting. Dennis made a motion to accept Gary's report. Kevin placed a second. The vote was unanimous.

Security and Fire – Dennis reported that he was working on new trespass signs. He said that he has about 10 ready for use. There was no other discussion concerning this committee.

Emergency Preparedness – Mike reported no progress on gaining permission to place signs near landing sites on member property owners' land. The Board reviewed the easement that exist along HPME roadways. As long as signage was placed in that easement, the HPME Board would be within its right. Mike led a discussion concerning the encouragement of landowners to develop an emergency plan of their own. Mike suggested that at the time of any true emergency, gates be left open. There was no other discussion from this committee.

Activities – Bruce requested that there be three breaks in the upcoming general meeting that he could draw for door prizes. He announced that the summer picnic would be held on August 3rd, this year. Mike and Debbie Schmidt have agreed to cook.

Development -- Kevin reported that he was still working on getting a written easement from the Byrum's allowing HPME access across their property. He reported that Roger McFarland would be the new chair of that committee. Kevin expressed his frustration in dealing with Cache County. He's made two attempts to discover properties in default of taxes and calls haven't been retruned.

Roads and Maintenance – With Ruby's absence, Farrel led a discussion of the continued distribution of gravel that has been stock piled at the East Spring. It is planned that that material will be spread in June. The work credit road maintainer signup sheet will be reactivated after the General Meeting.

Hunting – Rick led a discussion of the Board on proposed changes to hunting rights at the Association. He would like to see the moose hunter be limited to members and immediate member families. He would also like to see restrictions on hunting to only family members. He also proposed limiting permits to the general deer hunt to four permits per assessment. Rick was charged with putting something in writing to present at the March general meeting to the membership and leading a discussion at that gathering.

Water and Health – Nate shared Steve Wilson's waterflow reports for last year. He asked that they be placed on the website for review by landowners. There was a brief discussion on the abundance of water in the watershed this year.

Miscellaneous – There was a discussion of the upcoming election of officers at the general meeting. Kevin, Ruby, and Nate's positions would all be up for election. Farrel asked each member if they would be willing to continue. This was met with approval. Farrel also asked each member of the Board to be prepared for a 5-8 minute summary on the activity of the committee they supervise over the last year. All agreed.

Adjournment: At 9:15 PM, Rick made a motion to adjourn. This was seconded by Kevin. Vote was unanimous.
